O God, the pastor and ruler of all the faithful, mercifully look upon thy servant Damien, whom thou hast chosen to be the pastor and ruler of the Church in this Diocese: grant unto him, we beseech thee, to be in word and conversation a wholesome example to the people committed to his charge; that he with them may attain at last to the crown of everlasting life.
