Secret

We beseech thee, O Lord, mercifully to accept these our oblations: grant unto Damien, thy servant, that like as thou hast chosen him to be pastor and ruler of the Church in this Diocese; so he may be governed evermore by thy defence. Through...

Post-Communion

Defend us, O Lord, we beseech thee, who have here received these heavenly mysteries: and grant that thy servant Damien, whom thou hast chosen to be pastor and ruler of the Church in this Diocese; together with the flock committed to his charge, may thereby be preserved and strengthened against all adversities. Trinity Sunday

This is designated by the Diocese as Trinitarian Sunday and all Parishes and Missions are requested by the Council of Advice to donate their plate collections on this day to the Diocesan Office towards assisting the Diocese to subsidise the cost of purchasing additional copies of the Trinitarian for promotional opportunities.

World Mission Pence Fund

On the **First Sunday in Lent** Parishes and Missions are asked to donate the sum of their collection of pennies, made during the year, or such an amount as they have otherwise set aside to the Diocese for onward transmission to the Provincial Fund for World Mission.

(2008) – 20th September**
