This is designated by the Diocese as Trinitarian Sunday and all Parishes and Missions are requested by the Council of Advice to donate their plate collections on this day to the Diocesan Office towards assisting the Diocese to subsidise the cost of purchasing additional copies of the Trinitarian for promotional opportunities.

### **World Mission Pence Fund**

On the **First Sunday in Lent** Parishes and Missions are asked to donate the sum of their collection of pennies, made during the year, or such an amount as they have otherwise set aside to the Diocese for onward transmission to the Provincial Fund for World Mission.
